



CLUSTER Questions and Answers:

This is a continuation of reporting on the Questions and Answers that were raised during the March 2010 Tri-Parish Open Meetings concerning the new Mass Schedule and other Clustering Actions. This week will be a focus on questions regarding the RHCC Cluster Leadership Team.

Q. What is planned in terms of the Leadership for the RHCC Cluster that is to begin on June 29, 2010?

A. The Transition Team has asked Bishop Clark to appoint a Pastoral Administrator and 2 priest Sacramental Ministers. On Palm Sunday we were informed that the Bishop has appointed Barbara Swiecki, current Pastoral Administrator of Guardian Angels Parish as the Pastoral Administrator for the RHCC Cluster. We do expect Bishop Clark's official ap-

pointment letter in the coming days and expect to include it in the Bulletins.

Barbara is excited about this new opportunity and looks forward to working with all three parishes. Barbara will be sharing her vision for working with our joint ministries and serving the parishioners of our Cluster in upcoming forms including this Common Page.

We expect the Bishop will appoint 2 Sacramental Ministers sometime this Spring to begin on June 29. We anticipate these announcements in April.

Q. What is the status of the Deacons that currently serve our parishes?

A. The Pastoral Administrator of the Cluster will decide on the assignments of any appointed Deacons in cooperation with the DOR.

Q. When will the daily Mass Schedule be determined?

A. The 2 Sacramental Ministers will consult with the Combined Parish Pastoral Council and establish the daily Mass Schedule and locations.

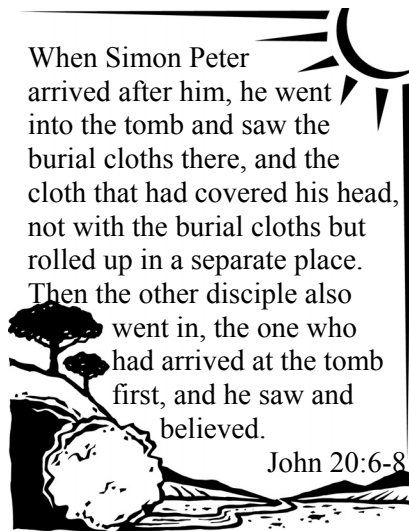

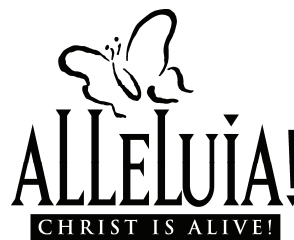
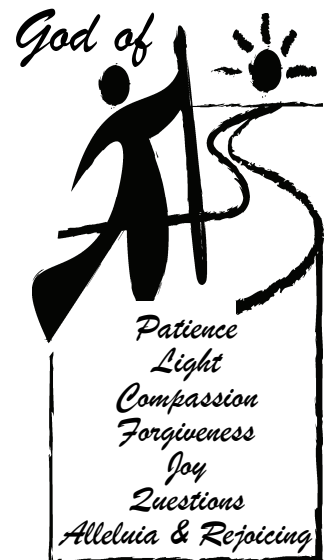
