8:30am at Good Shepherd

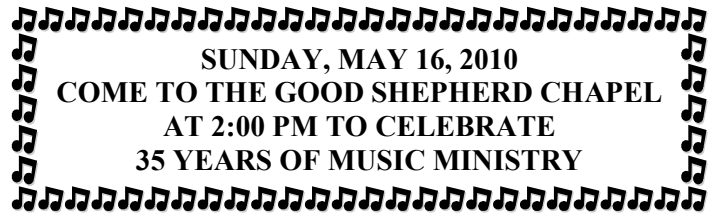
